

Anglican Board of Mission Lent and Good Friday Appeal 2024

The Lent appeal supports **Al Ahli Hospital in the Gaza Strip**. Before the current conflict, the hospital was running a child nutrition project. Their "Woman To Woman" project provided training in nutrition, self-esteem and communications skills. It is expected that when the conflict ceases, the needs will be even greater. Donations now will ensure vital health care is rapidly available to the vulnerable women and children of the Palestinian Territories when services resume.

The Anglican Diocese of Colombo, Sri Lanka is another area the Lent appeal will aid. This diocese runs an education and livelihood support project that provides educational and nutritional support for children, health care and social connections for communities in the North.

In **Kenya**, the **Anglicans Development Services Eastern** aids women in this drought-stricken country establish an income. The construction of a well in one neighbourhood reduced the walk for clean water from 10km to less than 1km.

Gifts to the Good Friday appeal will allow **Holy Land Institute for the Deaf** to purchase hearing aids for children in the refugee camps of **Jordan**.
